



## Potty Schedule Guideline

*Typically, a puppy will need to go outside every two to three hours not including after meals*

6:45 a.m. – Take puppy outside immediately after waking

7:15 a.m. – Feed puppy by hand

7:30 a.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

10:00 a.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

12:00 p.m. – Feed puppy by hand

12:15 p.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

2:30 p.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

(or bring him to the dog park if he has his 3 rounds of shots)

4:30 p.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

(or bring him home from dog park)

5:00 p.m. – Feed puppy by hand

5:15 p.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

7:30 p.m. – Remove puppy's water and any treats for the night (\*This is ONLY temporary until he is housetrained, you can provide several ice cubes)

8:30 p.m. – Take puppy outside to go potty

9:00 p.m. – Bring puppy in bedroom or kitchen to go to sleep (Give 2 ice cubes to puppy if you are removing his water)

Your puppy may not be able to go all night without taking care of business. Listen for any restlessness or whining, a sure sign that he needs to relieve himself. If he is making it all night with no problem, you can begin to give him access to his water through out the night.
